Half-Day Training: Understanding and Supporting Tourette Syndrome

Course content:

This training session will help school staff recognise and support pupils with Tourette Syndrome (TS), a neurological condition often diagnosed in childhood, more commonly in boys.

TS is characterised by motor and vocal tics lasting over a year, and can include hidden tics like impulsive thoughts or socially inappropriate urges.

Learn how tics can be temporarily suppressed (leading to 'tic attacks'), how anxiety and tiredness can make them worse, and why swearing tics (coprolalia) are uncommon despite media stereotypes.

We'll also explore the high rates of co-occurring conditions such as ADHD, OCD (including Tourettic OCD), anxiety, and sensory differences.

This session helps staff understand how TS may be mistaken for disruptive behaviour, why it's sometimes overlooked in diagnosis, and how to respond supportively.
